

HEALTH PROFESSIONAL CENTER (ZHTH)

ZHTH-1000 CPC Exam Prep 1.6 CEUs

This AAPC-approved, instructor-led course prepares students for the Certified Professional Coder (CPC) national certification exam through a mix of classroom lectures, reading assignments, practice exercises, timed tests and knowledge-based examinations. Students must attend all classroom hours and pass all course exams with a cumulative score of 70% or higher to earn a certificate of completion and CEUs. Prerequisites include: Minimum two years of related work experience and/or completion of medical coding course Medical terminology and anatomy and physiology knowledge obtained via prior coursework
